

To whom it may concern.

After the Earthquake that hit Nepal in April 2015, Kiran Namaste received € 15,000.-- ( Nrs 1,645,500.--)\* from various (private) donors to help the Kiran Namaste families in rebuilding their homes and lives.

It proved to be a difficult task to start with this immediately. The monsoon period made it difficult to reach the areas where the families live. On top of that, the the six months energy blockade affected Nepal badly and for a long period disrupted the country's daily life

The Kiran Namaste Foundation donated Nrs 136,200.-- for rebuilding the school the Kiran Namaste children attend.

The earthquake severely damaged the school's computer class and therefor we decided to donate three computers, six monitors and six keyboards in order for the children to continue with their education as soon as possible.


Furthermore, one of the Kiran Namaste women received Nrs 30,000.-- for immediate shelter as it was impossible for her to reach her family in one of the worst affected areas.

Nrs 825,000.-- was donated to five families ( Nrs 165,000.-- per family) to help them rebuild their house and start a new life.

At this moment there is still an amount of Nrs 654,300.-- left. We are currently assessing other immediate needs and subsequently the costs. As soon as we have a clear understanding of this we will take the initiative to act accordingly.
